6th Sunday of Easter

The First Reading speaks of the action of the Holy Spirit in guiding the growth of the early Church. The Apostles were not deciding who should be accepted into the Christian communion and who should not be; it was the Holy Spirit who was making that decision and giving clear signs of those choices. In the Second Reading, the letter does not define **love** as an emotion, but rather as an outpouring of oneself in the service of the other. God did this when He invited Jesus to die out of **Love** for us and taught us the true meaning of **Love**, which is a choice and not a feeling. How can we live in the **Love of God**? We must observe the commandments. On this final Sunday before the Ascension, we are invited to remember that the miracle of the Resurrection is ultimately one of **Love**, a **Love** that is so powerful that all forms of death are defeated by it.

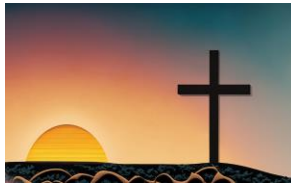
