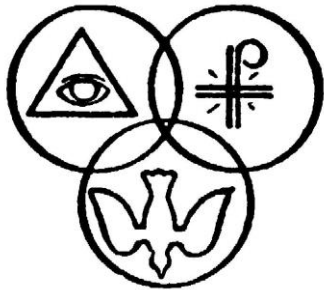

O my Jesus, forgive us our sins, save us from the fires of hell. Lead all souls to heaven especially those in most need of thy mercy.

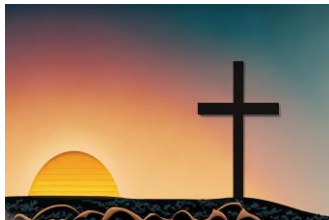
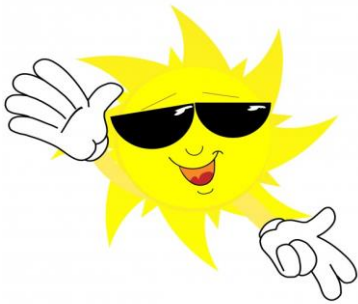
The Hail, Holy Queen (Salve Regina)
