

+Weekly Reflection on The Word of God TWENTY-FIRST SUNDAY OF ORDINARY

Today's Readings remind us that the Eucharist is not a right but a privilege, and one

that requires a certain degree of consistency. If we want to be one with the Lord, then we must give witness to that relationship in our everyday lives. The Second Reading speaks of the bond between husbands and wives as being analogous to the bond between Christ and the Church. In the Gospel we hear about those followers of Jesus who left Him because they could not accept His teaching on the Bread of Life. It is not always easy to believe the mysteries of our faith. We have to remember, though, that we can believe things without fully understanding them. Faith, ultimately, is not something to be analyzed; it is an act of trust. By professing our faith, we are saying that we trust in Jesus and in the mystery of God, even when, this is beyond our comprehension.

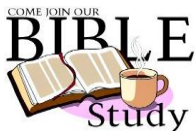

Women Needed for the Seven Sisters Apostolate

Do you want to support our priests?

Join the Seven Sisters Apostolate here at Estancia Valley Catholic Parish, starting its second year at our parish.

What is Seven Sisters?

A lay apostolate to strengthen the Church by praying for our priests. (National website: www.sevensistersapostolate.org)

How does it work?

Seven “sisters” (i.e., seven women) form a group to offer prayers to support each priest. Each Sister prays one holy hour each week on her assigned day, for her assigned priest (either Father Lancaster or Father Emmanuel). Each Sister commits to the holy hour for one year.

You can do a day by yourself or team with other women if a weekly commitment does not work for your schedule. This covers our priests with one hour of prayer in the presence of the Blessed Sacrament each day of the year. You can pray at any Church and at any time.
