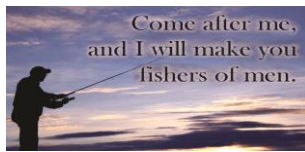

Blessing of throats occurs on the Feast of St. Blaise, Friday, February 3<sup>rd</sup>. St. Blaise, Biagio in Italian, Blasco or Blas in Spanish, was a bishop of Sebaste, Armenia, in modern Turkey. He was martyred for witnessing to the faith and was tortured and beheaded for his beliefs by the local Roman governor around AD 316. This is all that is known about him, the rest being legend. More is known about devotion to and the popularity of St. Blaise than historical facts. The special blessing of throats associated with St. Blaise is due to a miracle attributed to him. While in prison, he miraculously saved a boy choking on a fish bone. Early sixth century evidence exists in the Eastern Church that Blaise was prayed to for ailments of the throat. We will have Blessing of the Throats at the 7:30 a.m. and 5:30 p.m. Masses at Our Lady of Mount Carmel on Saturday, February 3<sup>rd</sup> and following all weekend Masses on February 4<sup>th</sup>.

It takes many people to have a meaningful and dignified funeral service, whether it includes a Rosary, a Vigil Service, or the holy sacrifice of the Mass. The office staff and our volunteers and ministers help with these services. Out of consideration for them, we do not schedule a funeral Mass with less than three working days' notice. After notification of a death to the parish office, and if arrangements can be made, a Rosary can be scheduled, but a Mass will not be scheduled until the third working day after a death notification to the parish office.
