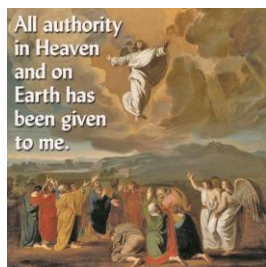

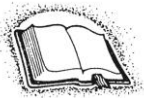
WORD OF LIFE
