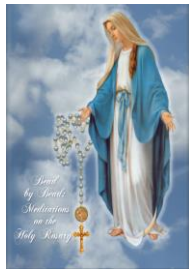

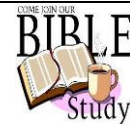
EVCP PRAYER NETWORK MINISTRY

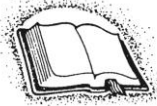
