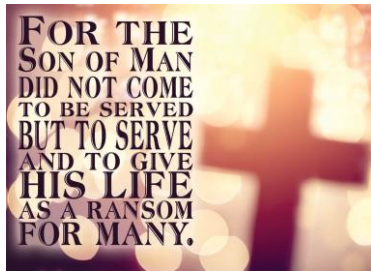

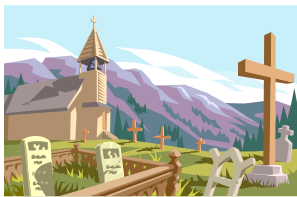

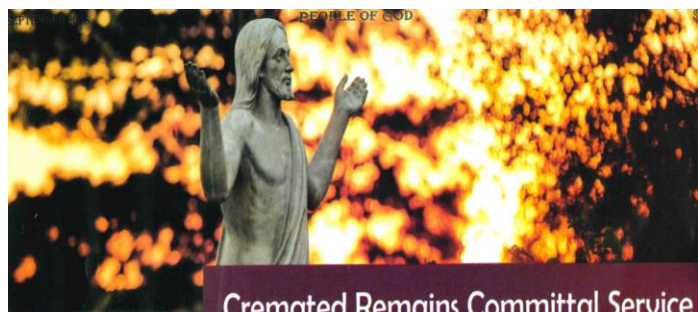

**Cremated Remains Committal Service  
November 2, 2018  
All Souls' Day**



In 2011, with guidance from Archbishop Michael Sheehan, the Catholic Cemetery Association introduced the Cremated Remains Committal Program. This program offers families a NO COST, perpetual care placement of cremated remains. In the weeks leading up to All Souls' Day, families make arrangements to participate in this program, and on that day, a Memorial Service is celebrated in memory of those laid to rest. Family and friends of those individuals, as well as the Community are invited to attend. Mass is celebrated followed by a procession to the gravesite and Committal Service.

If you are currently caring for a loved one's cremated remains at home and would like more information on this year's program, please contact Mt. Calvary Cemetery in Albuquerque or Rosario Cemetery in Santa Fe.

- Schedule an appointment to speak with an advisor.
- Arrangements and paperwork must be completed no later than October 30, 2018.
- Invite family and friends to attend the service.
